Elocution Competition (Feb 14, 2025)

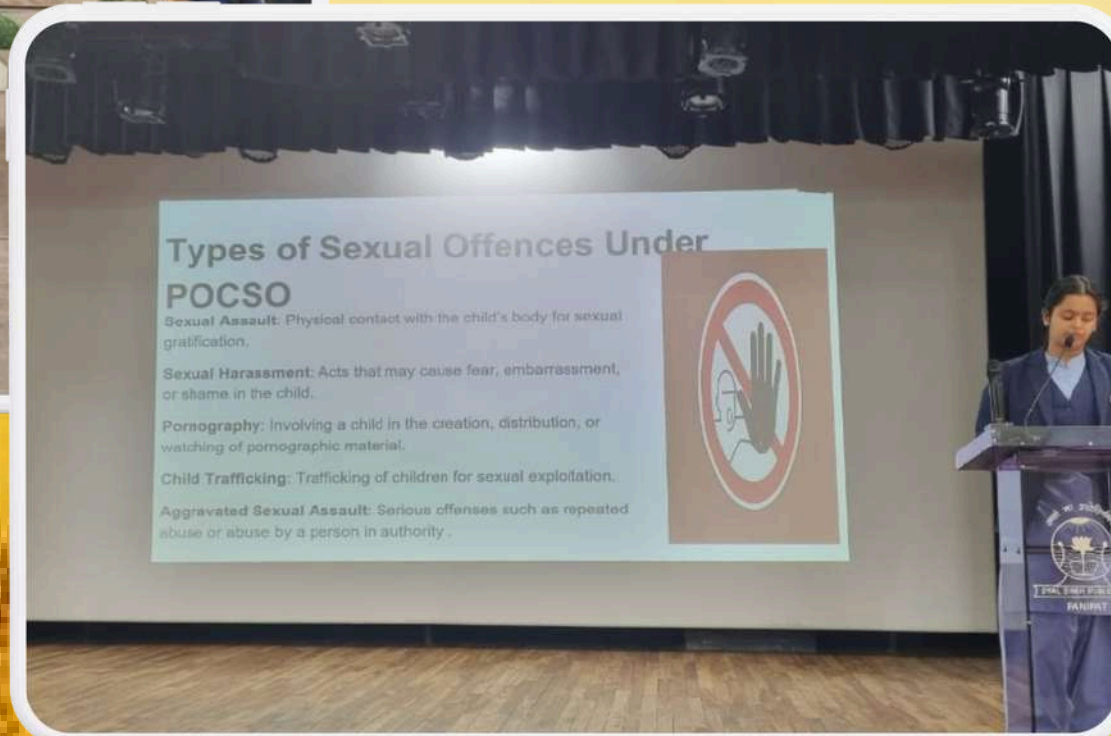

NUKKAD NATAK (Feb 22, 2025)



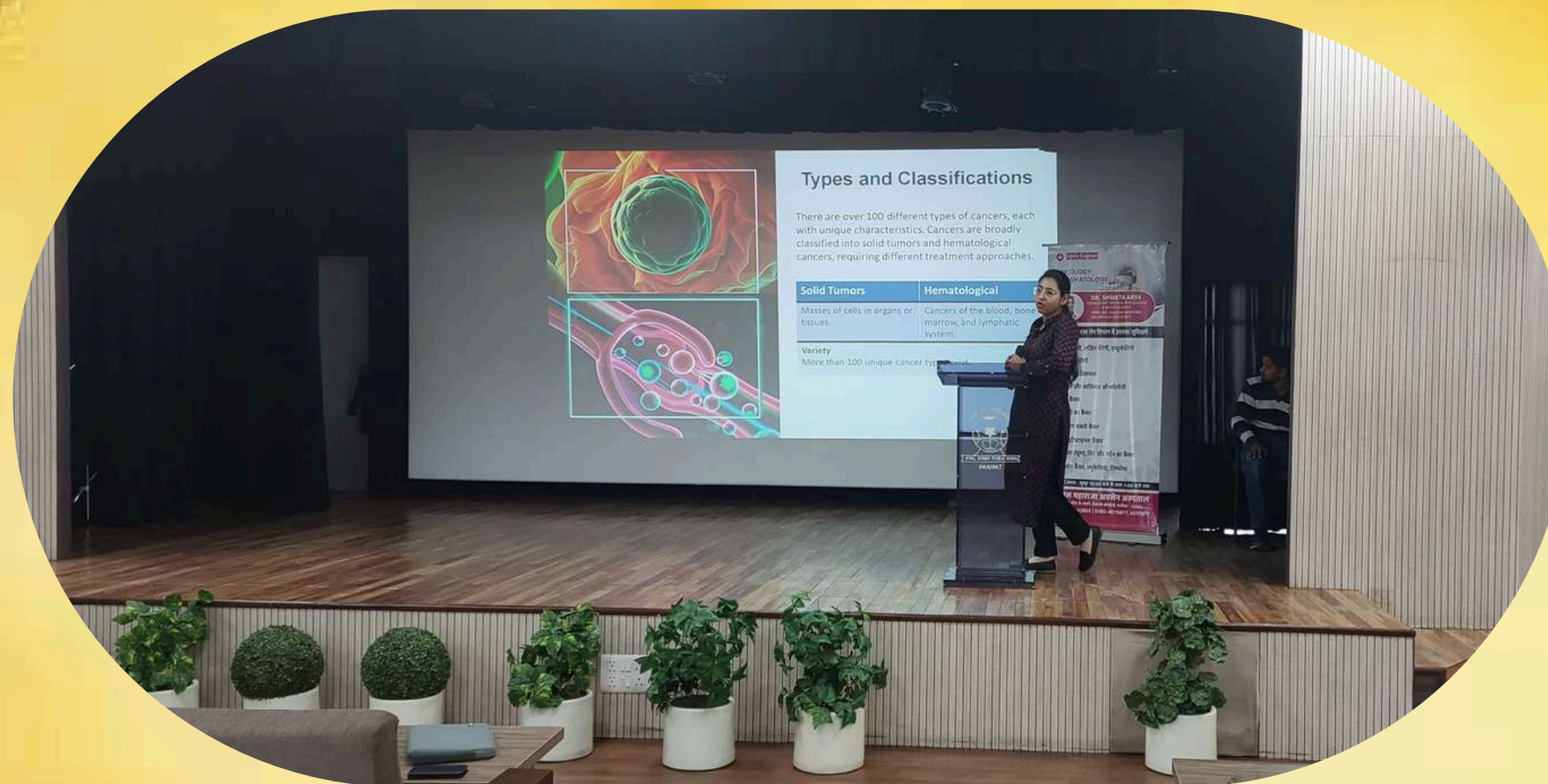

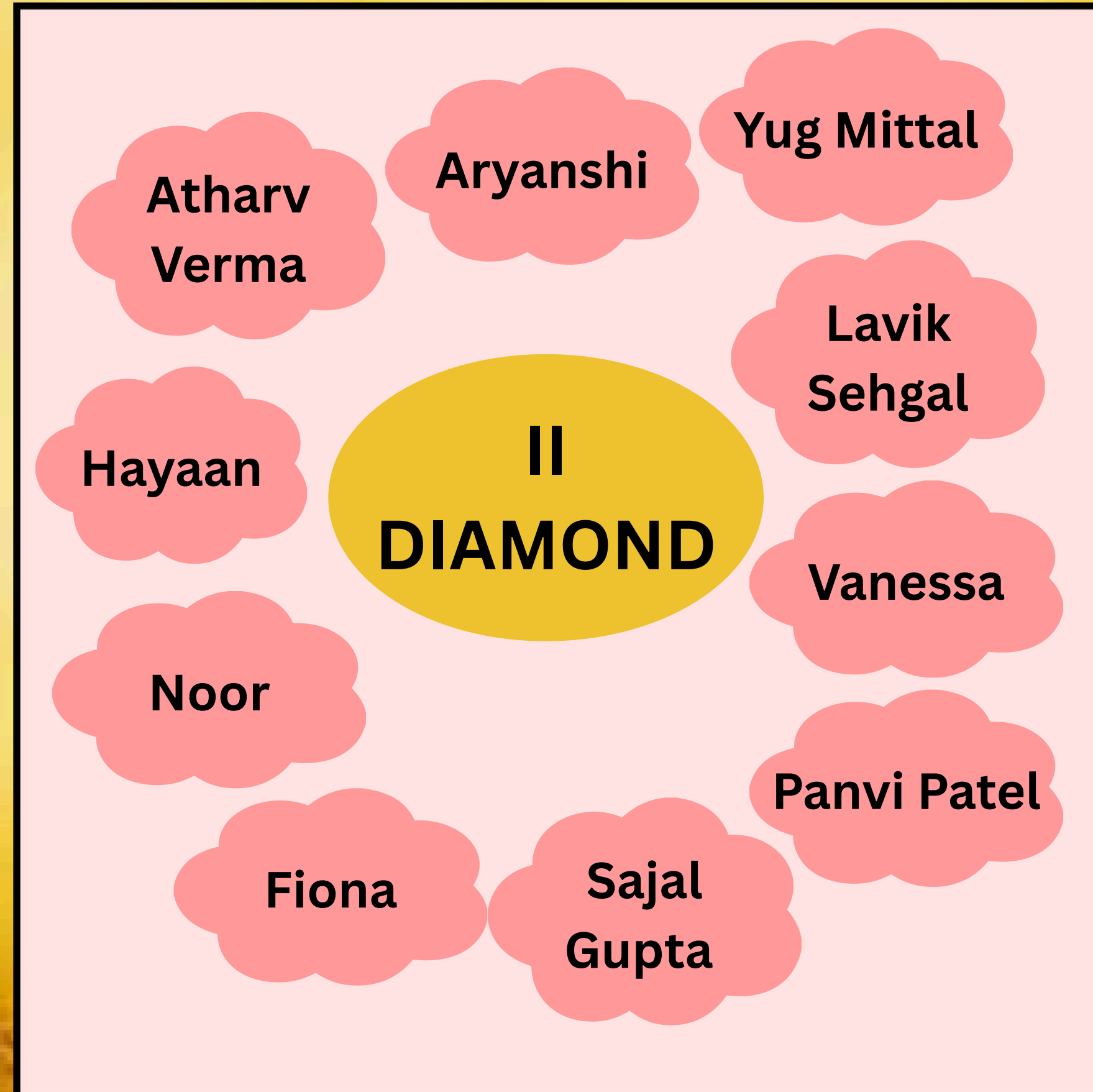
